Women Inventors for Automobiles

Prior to the manufacture of Henry Ford's Model A, Mary Anderson was granted her first patent for a window cleaning device in November of 1903. Her invention could clean snow, rain, or sleet from a windshield by using a handle inside the car. Her goal was to improve driver vision during stormy weather - Mary Anderson invented the windshield wiper.

During a trip to New York City, Mary Anderson noticed that streetcar drivers had to open the windows of their cars when it rained in order to see, as a solution she invented a swinging arm device with a rubber blade that was operated by the driver from within the vehicle via a lever. The windshield wipers became standard equipment on all American cars by 1916.

The automobile gave women ample opportunity for invention. In 1923, of the 345 inventions listed under "Transportation" in the Women's Bureau Bulletin No.28, about half were related to automobiles and another 25 concerned traffic signals and turn indicators. Among these inventions -- a carburetor, a clutch mechanism, an electric engine starter, and a starting mechanism.



Columbia Star Dinner Train

Sunday, November 3rd, 2013 Columbia, MO

Members of the St. Louis Gateway Section caravanned to Columbia, Missouri on Sunday morning, November 3rd, to take a ride and have brunch on the "Columbia Star" train. We were met at the train station in Columbia by some of our members who live in the western part of Missouri.

The Columbia Star train was featured on the PBS show "Great Scenic Railway Journeys". The train is comprised of two locomotives and three cars. A locomotive is located on each end of the train so that the train may operate in either direction. The F-7 locomotives were built by the Electro-Motive Division (EMD) of General Motors in 1948 and 1953. These locomotives were originally built for the Great Northern Railroad. The dining cars were built by the Pullman Car Company in 1938 for the Southern Pacific Railroad as coach cars. Later, they were converted to dining cars for dinner train service. Originally these cars served on the famous Southern Pacific train named the "Daylight", running between Los Angeles and San Francisco. These cars are unique in that they are articulated, meaning that they share a set of trucks (wheels) between the two car bodies. The kitchen car is a former Chicago Burlington and Quincy (CB&Q) baggage car. This car has been converted to a full kitchen and all meals are prepared onboard the train. The kitchen car is in the middle of the train so meals are served out of both ends of the car to the adjoining dining cars.

We boarded the train and were directed to one of the dining cars reserved for our club members only. After we were all seated the train departed. Traveling at 10-25 mph, the train headed north towards Centralia, MO. As we were served a delicious four course meal, the Missouri countryside passed by in beautiful sunshine. About an hour out of the station the train stopped and began heading back towards our starting point in Columbia. We continued our conversations over coffee and desert, and enjoyed the peaceful train ride. The time passed quickly and before we knew it we were back at the station. After saying our farewells to the train staff and to our friends we headed back to our respective homes having enjoyed a truly enjoyable Sunday afternoon. If you drop \$100,000 on a luxury sedan, it seems only reasonable to receive some preferential treatment at the dealership you purchased from. After all, that price isn't just for the car – you're paying for the brand and all the cachet that entails. For Mercedes-Benz, those benefits have apparently been lacking relative to the German brand's luxury competitors.

That's set to change, though, as Automotive News reports that the German brand is placing a much greater emphasis on keeping its customers happy and loyal with its MB Select program. Starting with the new S-Class and spreading to the CLA-Class (and eventually beyond), dealers are being given money - up to \$2,500 in the case of the flagship sedan - just to improve the customer experience.

We agree, improving the "customer experience" is quite a vague term, so it's nice that Mercedes USA's CEO, Steve Cannon, offered up some examples to Automotive News at the LA Auto Show. For example, a customer couldn't fit his sunglasses into the overhead compartment. "So we bought him a pair of Ray-Ban sunglasses that fit because of their shape," Cannon said.

Another buyer had an issue with a fussy check engine light, which required a quick software reflash. "The problem was fixed immediately, but we said that does not happen with the S-Class, the best car in the world. Dinner is on us. That customer was so thrilled he came in the next day and bought an SL off the showroom floor," Cannon told Automotive News.

Dealers seem to be onboard with the new program, as well. Automotive News spoke to Josepeh Agresta, the chairman of the Mercedes Dealer Board. "This was Mercedes-Benz putting their money where their mouth is about customer service and empowering people at the front of the line both at their organization and the dealer network to make quick decisions and to try to help customers out in difficult situations with a new car."

Crystal Ball: 2016 Mercedes-Benz GLK-Class

Mercedes-Benz has been caught testing camouflaged prototypes of its second-generation 2016 GLK-Class. The next GLK will be based on the all-new C-Class for 2015, which will share more components with the E-Class platform, meaning more engine variety under the bonnet. Here's a specific benefit of this cross-platform sharing: Car and Driver says Mercedes is mulling a GLK AMG. Efficiency fans: never fret – Car and Driver is also reporting the GLK250 BlueTEC with its 2.1L biturbo diesel will likely live on. A hybrid version could also debut in the GLK's next life cycle.



St. Louis Motor Carriage Company was a manufacturer of automobiles at 1211–13 North Vandeventer Avenue in St. Louis, Missouri founded by George Preston Dorris (later credited with developing and patenting the float-carburetor) and John French in 1898, with French taking charge of marketing and Dorris heading engineering and production. St. Louis Motor Carriage was the first of many St. Louis automakers and produced automobiles from 1899 to 1907.

In 1900, John French drove to St. Louis on the first automobile trip between St. Louis and Chicago. In 1901 he was one of only three drivers to finish in a New York-to-Buffalo race.

The St. Louis Motor Carriage Company moved to Peoria, Illinois in 1905, and Dorris started his own car company, the Dorris Motor Car Co., in the former St Louis Motor Carriage plant in 1906 that would stay in business until 1926.

The 1904 St. Louis line included runabout and touring car models. Both could be equipped with a tonneau, with seating for up to five passengers. The runabout sold for \$1200 and used a 9 hp (6.7 kW) engine. The touring car was priced at \$1500. It used a flat-mounted, water-cooled, single-cylinder engine, situated amidships of the car, producing 10 hp (7.5 kW). A two-speed transmission was fitted, and the angle iron-framed car weighed 1650 lb (748 kg).

New Mercedes C-Class (2014) officially revealed

Codenamed W205, the latest C-Class sits on the new modular rear-drive chassis architecture (MRA) that will underpin every large Mercedes for the next five years. This has the capacity for hybrid and electric power, four-wheel drive and a wide range of different vehicle shapes and sizes all built into its structural DNA.

The brand has taken its opportunity to introduce the kind of state-of-the-art technology and luxurious finish that established the S-Class as such a dominant class leader.

The crystal-clear digital TFT screens (one between the dials and a tablet-style display on the center console) features pin-sharp color graphics, and the clickable touchpad control is the kind of new technology that'll soon be the industry standard.

The key to the new chassis is its light weight, and this theme continues throughout the car - 50 per cent of the body is now made from aluminum, so even though the new C-Class is 95mm longer and 40mm wider than before, it's up to 100kg lighter.

The new C220 BlueTEC diesel has a drag coefficient of 0.24Cd – better than most coupés – and when combined with the lighter body, Mercedes claims to have cut fuel consumption by 20 per cent. This means the 168 bhp saloon, which can cover 0-62mph in 8.1 seconds, also emits 103g/km of CO2 – easily beating BMW's most frugal 320d EfficientDynamics (which emits 109g/km).

Joining the C220 at launch will be C180 and C200 petrol models. The C180 uses a 154bhp 1.6-litre engine that emits just 116g/km of CO2, while the C200 features a 184bhp 2.0-litre, does 0-62mph in 7.5 seconds but still emits less CO2 than a VW Golf 1.4 TSI.

Soon after the new C-Class hits showrooms in March, Mercedes will introduce a much wider selection of engines, with an even cleaner 1.6-litre diesel sourced from Renault used to bring headline CO2 figures well below the 100g/km barrier.

Also following will be a 330 bhp petrol V6, and by the end of 2014 the full-blooded V8 AMG version will have joined the range. Plus, the C-Class will take its lead from the S-Class by offering a choice of petrol and diesel hybrids. The C300 BlueTEC HYBRID uses the same technology as the E-Class, but promises 72.4mpg.

In another first for Mercedes, the new C-Class will be available with 4MATIC all-wheel drive.
