

For those of you who may not be familiar with Autogeek, they started about 15 years ago and have become a major supplier of just about any auto detailing product or accessory you can think of. They also do a fantastic job of educating anyone who wants to learn more about which products to use and the proper way to make your car look the best that it can. Autogeek Show Car Garage is the place where Autogeek films their detailing videos. Our host from Autogeek will be Mike Phillips. Mike has over 33 years of experience in the field of auto detailing and reconditioning and a true passion for automobiles. He has over 250 articles to his credit and he has hosted two full-length instructional videos for Autogeek. Mike has taught countless detailing classes since 1988 and has been a guest speaker at numerous car club events and car shows. Prior to working at Autogeek, Mike worked at Meguiar's as a sales rep/trainer for Oregon, Washington and Northern Idaho training body shop and dealership technicians how to use Meguiar's professional detailing products. Later, he became the online administrator and instructor of Meguiar's detailing classes. In 2009, he joined Autogeek as Director of Training. He's appeared on Two Guys Garage, Motorhead Garage, My Classic Car, and is the host of Autogeek's "What's in the Garage?" on the Fox Sports Network.

Tour of the new Elliott Museum in Stuart, FL April 13, 2013

On Saturday morning, April 13, 2013, 42 Road Star members met at the new Elliott Museum in Stuart, Florida for a tour of their new facility. After undergoing a \$20 million dollar 'green' re-building, the new 48,000-square-foot Elliott Museum opened on March 3, 2013. The museum has been a Martin County institution for 53 years. Among the many attractions, the most unique is the only automated storage and retrieval system used in a museum to store and display vehicles. The museum has a 3 story storage area that stores all of its antiques autos except those on display on the museum floor. When needed by a visitor for viewing purposes, a robotic cart moves to the storage location, rolls the car onto a moving platform that is brought to the display area where the car is placed on a turn table for display. When needed, the robot carrier retrieves the car and places it back in it's storage location. In addition, the Museum is celebrating its opening with a world-renown exhibit, **Leonardo daVinci: Machines in Motion** – a dramatic hands-on display of forty, full-size machine replicas made directly from Leonardo's innovative designs and drawings. The exhibit debuts the museum's new, 3,000-square-foot "**Changing Exhibition Gallery**" which allows the new Elliott Museum, for the first time, to bring significant, nationally-touring exhibitions to the region. In fact, the opening at the new Elliott Museum represents the first time the exhibit appears anywhere in Florida. The exhibit will run through September.

Our tour was led by Mr. Albert Simbritz, a volunteer coordinator at the Museum, who did an outstanding job of explaining both the history of the exhibits as well as their impact on today's life. Mr. Simbritz is somewhat of a "gearhead" like many of our members and was a former sales executive for many years with the General Motors Corp. which gave him a unique perspective on many of the autos on display, their contributions to technology and growth of the auto industry back in those times. The tour was followed by a lunch at the Pirate's Cove restaurant in Port Salerno where many positive comments about the tour and tour guide were heard against many wishes to "let's do this again". We certainly intend to do so.
