

Atlantic City Expressway westbound to Exit 41 and turn left at the top of the exit. Proceed approximately 3 miles and make a left onto Fries Mill Rd. Proceed approximately 1/4 mile to Scotland Run Golf Club.

FROM TRENTON AND NORTHERN NEW JERSEY:

Interstate 295 South to Route 42 South. Take Route 42 South to the AC Expressway. Take the Atlantic City Expressway to Exit 41 and turn right at the top of the exit. Proceed approximately 3 miles and make a left onto Fries Mill Rd. Proceed approximately 1/4 mile to Scotland Run Golf Club.

FROM WILMINGTON AND POINTS SOUTH:

Interstate 95 North to Commodore Barry Bridge to Route 322 East OR New Jersey Turnpike North to Exit 2 to Route 322 East... Follow Route 322 East through Glassboro and continue on Route 322 for approximately 3 miles to Fries Mill Road. Turn left on Fries Mill Road and proceed 1/4 mile to Scotland Run Golf Club.

The club will meet at the Woodcrest PATCO station (the high-speed line) at 7:15 AM and take the 7:33 train into Philadelphia. Train tickets are sold from vending machines only, no ticket windows, so please bring paper and coin currency that is accepted at a machine (not the dirty old bills). The Woodcrest Station is at Exit 31 on I-295.

We are set to enter the show at 8 AM, an hour before the rest of the show opens, for our exclusive access to the Mercedes-Benz exhibit.

The club will collect \$5.00 per person for a donation to the The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. This enables us to match the contribution the Car Show is making to the hospital.

After our private tour of the MB exhibit, we are free to roam the auto show. Those of us interested in a dutch-treat lunch at a local restaurant usually venture back to the train station around noon-ish. Feel free to come or spend the day in the city.


