

MBCA-SJS owes its continued existence to the hard work and dedication of Werner, who was more than a leader—to many of us, he was a dear friend as much as a club mentor. His happy and helpful presence will be greatly missed at our events. Below, SJS Secretary Danny Goldberg memorializes Werner on behalf of us all.

I will say that, to me, MBCA (and its sections) are as much about people as they are about cars. My wife, Debbie and I feel Werner and Nancy are central to that description of MBCA. Werner, who I met through the club, became a personal friend who like me was a diesel head and advanced stage shade tree mechanic. He was someone who understood cars and enjoyed working on and taking about Mercedes Diesels.

A devotee of MBCA and a die-hard section leader, Werner enjoyed what most club members don't - being a leader, devoting time and effort to events and encouraging others to volunteer. As our section's "elder statesman" he sometimes felt we were not doing enough and was not shy about letting us know. At times his "by the book" approach to running a section, -- an event every month, six news letters a year and attending national events seemed unrealistic. But in his own good natured way even when he was clearly "outvoted" by the rest of us, he never relented and in his affable way keep talking about National's procedures manual.

What's more, Werner practiced what he preached: He was always generous in allowing the South Jersey section to hold an annual blueberry picnic and car show at his farm. It is one of our section's most popular events and Werner was always there at the grill making knockwurst, talking Mercedes and Club and encouraging members to pick blueberries.

As a Regional Director, Werner took his responsibilities for "his" sections personally. They were almost like his children or grandkids. As a hands-on leader he visited the sections and


