## Friday Fun – MBCA National Board Meeting

While the National Board members of MBCA were busy holding their meetings at the *Bellasera* on Friday, a group of their spouses, along with some of our own SWFL Section members, took in a couple of local Naples places of interest.

We began our morning with a tour of the *Palm Cottage* on 12<sup>th</sup> Ave South. It is the oldest remaining house in Naples, built in 1895. Although the cottage looks to be quite small from the street, appearances can be deceiving. The interior is quite large and full of historical photos, furnishings, and memorabilia.



Our docent, Jerry, was really informative and well versed in the history of this house and the role it played in the growth of Naples.

Even the members of our group that currently live in Naples learned a lot about how it grew from wilderness to be the beautiful city that it is today. And although many of us may have realized that Barron Collier, the namesake of Collier County, was a wealthy man, we did not know the story of his humble beginnings and dedicated work ethic, not only as a worker, but also as an employer. Because of his concern for the well-being of his employees the entire Tamiami trail was completed through the Everglades without a single fatality. It is a truly inspiring story. I would highly recommend this tour to anyone interested in the historical past. I think it is a relatively unknown gem. They also rent out the house and beautiful adjacent garden for social events. You might keep that in mind if you are looking for a quaint venue for private affair.

After the tour of Palm Cottage we headed to lunch at *Brambles Tea Room*, tucked away in the back of the Landmark Building on 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue South. The atmosphere is cozy and the staff was gracious and attentive. We were offered 3 types of tea to choose from, as well as an assortment of 4 types of sandwiches and a delicious scone served with clotted cream and jam. It was a pleasant way to get to know each other and chat over a nice cup of tea. I learned from Trish (originally from

England but now in Western Michigan) that Earl Grey with Vanilla is nothing like Earl Grey with a spot of milk, which is how it is done in the UK. The Brits know their tea! Friday evening, after the National Board members finished their meetings, we ended our day by joining them at a cocktail party at Wahoo's River Bar and Grill near the Naples Airport. Great food, cold drinks, and good friends came together. One of our Section members set up a slot car track for the enjoyment of the guests. The Section continues to enjoy unprecedented membership growth, which results in increased rebates of member dues from the MBCA Nation Business Office (NBO). The rebates are provided by NBO to each section to help defray local section operating costs. Also, our Section has enjoyed generous support from local businesses advertising in the Section's newsletter. In addition, we continue to have significantly reduced printing and postage costs by distributing our award winning newsletter primarily by email.

We continue to utilize some of the available cash to underwrite the cost of a number of events for members during our busy winter season. We partially subsidized two major section events, the annual Holiday Party and the annual Farewell Picnic. We provided gift baskets for several section events, including two Ladies of Mercedes events, the annual Fort Myers car show, and the Holiday Party, purchased several MBCA items for drawings at the Holiday Party, and we purchased supplies and drinks for the Farewell Picnic. #### ForSaleSold... like that!

As I'm writing to thank you for another excellent newsletter, the thought occurred to me to share the best club benefit I've received to date.

When Carol and I were here in July, I made Tom Starrett a solemn promise to fly here for Octoberfest. In August, I found the S500 and decided to sell the 450SL when we returned to Ft. Myers. Coming here for Octoberfest and then driving down here 2 weeks later was probably not the smartest use of time and energy, but a 14 year birthday on October 14 for our youngest grandchild was a must (as was a promise to Tom).

As you both know, the 450 was officially FOR SALE at Punta Gorda.

On Wednesday, the 19th, I took photos of the car in a beautiful spot and was quite proud of my efforts. Then I recalled, Jerry, you commenting at Punta Gorda that Mario gets more out his photos of a car than most.

I knew I wanted to use Hemmings because Mario had shared with me his success with them earlier this year. I also knew I was asking a good price (\$25,000) for the car ( the last I looked, out of 18 1980 450 SL's listed, only 5 were over \$20,000).

I called Mario and asked for his help with the photos. He said he would be glad to and we met on Thursday, the 20th. He did his

thing......hardtop on, then off. Soft top up and then topless. As I waited for the time for photos, I got busy with the copy that the Hemmings form provides for and thought about how to get the photos and description together for submission. Called Mario and he said send it to him and he would take care of it. After the photo session I gave him money to submit the ad and the next day it was on line. I found out later about cropping and rewriting until it was just right.

The most brilliant thing about my copy was to suggest to Mario to edit as he saw fit......(Jerry, I told you I need an editor, and as you are seeing, I still do)! The first response was from Portland, OR.

The second response was from Athens, Greece. Cash in Ft. Myers sent that one away. That is when Mario said that he would meet any prospective buyer or buyers representative with me. He also suggested using his warehouse as a place to show the car. The stipulation was I would talk price and other information.

The third response was from Indiana on Monday last week to see if the car was still available. He would come to Ft. Myers on Friday to look at and drive the car. At Mario's suggestion, we put the car at his place, covered it and decided to uncover it once the soon-to-be buyer arrived. The look on his face as we did the uncovering (or should I

say, unveiling) was priceless.

It was perfect. The prospect only spent 10 minutes driving it, came back and said, "I want this". Wrote the check for the full amount and came back Saturday for a successful delivery. Incidentally, the check cleared the bank immediately Friday.

Here's my purpose for writing. Mario Puente agreed to help a fellow club member without hesitation. However, I think he has a valuable talent for this and others could really benefit from his service. I paid him after the fact, not because he asked, but because as this process evolved, it became obvious that this was a service to assist me sell the car. I have no idea if I gave him enough or not but as we discussed afterward, he did more than I expected and I'm sure more than he did. The next person would pay based on the situation, I'm sure.

The photos, the copy, the car, the price all go into the effort and Mario will give his opinion. For example, my price was "plenty" and one of my responses to an email inquiry was that I was a "tough cookie".

All I know is I got my price in 14 days.
