#### NOTICE to SECTION

As outlined in the President's Remarks in the December 2022 – January 2023 issue of the *Badger Star*, your Section has not received any financial support from the National Organization since January 2021.

That means the Section has had virtually no source of income to support our Section's activities for over two years.

One of those activities is the printing and mailing of a paper copy of the *Badger Star* to all members who prefer a paper copy of the newsletter over an electronic version.

The costs of paper, printing and postage have all risen significantly in the last two years. It now costs our Section approximately \$500.00 per year to print and mail paper copies of the *Badger Star*. This is a cost that up to now has come from our dwindling cash reserves.

For that reason, the Board has decided to request members who receive a printed newsletter to pay for the cost of that printed newsletter, i.e. to reimburse the Section for the paper, printing and postage costs.

About 9% of our membership will be affected by this policy.

This new policy will go into effect with the December 2023-January 2024 issue. Those affected by the policy will be notified no later than October 17, 2023 what the amount will be to continue to receive the *Badger Star* in printed form. The amount may change annually based on costs at the time.

The reimbursement is entirely voluntary. However, those members who do not wish to reimburse the Section will no longer receive a printed newsletter but instead will receive an electronic version if we have their email address. Members who do not have an email address and do not reimburse the Section will no longer receive the *Badger Star*.


This decision was made with great reluctance, but we feel we don't have a choice given the current circumstances. National leadership has told all Sections not to expect any financial support in the future, and short of finding someone willing to sponsor an event or advertise in the *Badger Star* we have to live with the cash we do have.

## Mercedes Me or Mercedes Me connect

Have you ever bought a new Mercedes and lost the owner's manual or maybe purchased a used one that didn't have the owner's manual? As you know, the Mercedes-Benz dealerships are more than willing to help you with any request you have. Most people just stop there, so let's drive further down the road a bit to look at some modernized Mercedes-Benz options available to owners. While looking at the 2022 marque, we should investigate the mini-computer devices we call smartphones. Mercedes Benz has two apps in the Android and iPhone app stores available. One app is called "Mercedes me" and the other "Mercedes me connect" for 2018 and newer vehicles. These two apps have a vast amount of knowledge about your vehicle or multiple vehicles. My own personal vehicle is shaded gray because it is not connected, but it still gives me a list of dealers and all Owner's Manuals that were created. The Owner's Manuals can be downloaded to your smartphone, emailed to others, or even shared to your home computer. After emailing them to your home computer, you could print it out if you want a paper copy too. The apps even provide you with direct contact information for Roadside Assistance! After Roadside Assistance, the app gives more access to the Mercedes Benz Lifestyle which gives you direct access to Mercedes AMG gear and other items from the Mercedes-Benz Lifestyle Collection. You can then live the Lifestyle by seeing what is new in the world of Mercedes-Benz accessories, gear, and merchandise. The app will also give you access to the "mbrace Technology of Mercedes-Benz". At the bottom, you can command access to other apps like 'connect' and 'finance', and other departments. The 3 lines or 3 bars at the top give even more access in list format. Activity is where Mercedes-Benz can send you information about all updates to your vehicle. 'My Profile' is where you edit and add your personal vehicle information. 'My vehicles' are where you see a list of your Mercedes-Benz vehicles that you can add/remove or edit the information. 'My Dealers' is where you can save your favorite dealers. 'App settings' allow you to control the notification, pass-code, and vehicle data, and so much more. We all love our Mercedes vehicles and many of us wear our Mercedes gear proudly, but why not download all the Mercedes-Benz apps to your smartphone for easier and quicker access to Mercedes information?


