





**Stars of The Movie Colony Walking Tour:** This was one of the first, and certainly most posh, residential developments in old Palm Springs and it quickly became the private refuge of Hollywood royalty. **Spencer's Restaurant:** Nestled at the base of the San Jacinto Mountains on the Racquet Club grounds we will have a private garden room. They offer a three-course Prix Fixe Menu, with many appetizer, entrée and dessert offerings available. Price is \$59/person plus tax and tip of \$17/person. All beverages extra.


