



THE WILD AND WACKY WORLD OF EXOTIC CARS

Welcome to this month's edition of the WWWEC.

As summer fades into fall, the heat and humidity are still with us. The normal summer full of car shows and events is winding down to football season.

As always, the crown jewel of the summer shows is the Pebble Beach Concours. And the star of this year's Concours winning best of show was a Mercedes 540K. You can see excellent coverage of the entire Pebble Beach car week on You Tube. Everyone has a camera now and they all post everything on You Tube. The coverage of everything from the Quail, the Concorso Italiano and the Sunday Concours is so thorough you will feel like you are there. While everyone should attend the Concours, at least once, it's a whole lot cheaper on You Tube.

Mercedes, not to be outdone by one of its classic cars, announced its new AMG GT. Essentially, it's the hardtop version of the new SL introduced last fall. It will come in two versions the GT55 with 469hp and the GT63 with 577hp. It will be the first time the GT will have standard all-wheel drive and rear wheel steering. While it will have four seats and other new equipment and technology, it will also be heavier. The car will weigh over 4300 lbs., which is heavier than the last GT by a good margin. It's certainly not a lightweight sports car. The car will be available early next year with pricing expected to start at \$142,000 for the 55 and \$184,000 for the 63. Of course, the options list will be substantial.

The hottest ticket for the fall is the new F1 race in Las Vegas in November. We talked about this at the last meeting but for those of you who weren't there I thought it would be interesting to cover the outrageous cost of going to the race. There are a number of race packages available as well as single race day tickets available. Race day only tickets are several thousand dollars each if you can find any. If you want a place to

stay and tickets to the race, etc., you will need to buy a package. Here are some of the packages available and the pricing. For \$8,000 a person, you can get a three-day ticket for the Heineken House which gives you food and beverage service but no hotel, etc. For \$11,247 you can get a three-day ticket at the Bellagio Fountain Club which includes food and drink for the three days but no rooms. For those of you with too much money and no place to spend it, The Wynn offers their million dollar all access experience. This gets you the three-day ticket package, three nights in a three-bedroom duplex, and food and drink for six people. Transportation not included. Not to be outdone, Caesars has the Emperor Package which includes five nights in the 10,000 SF Nobu Sky Villa, meals, drinks, a chauffeured Rolls-Royce and an Adele concert. You also get the three-day race tickets. The price if you have to ask is only \$5M. Transportation to and from Las Vegas not included.


