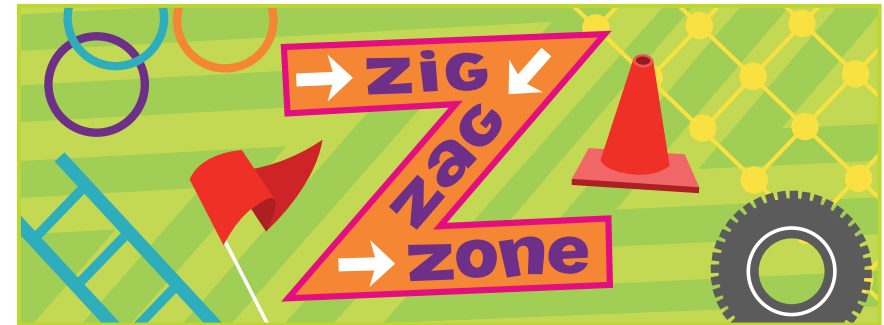

MORNING TIME

When you go into your child's room this month say, "Good morning! Where's my sweet [child's name]? There you are! Mommy/Daddy is here to help you because I love you."

CUDDLE TIME
