

## **How to Demonstrate Complexity**

| Complexity Level      | Factors  |
|-----------------------|--|
| 97165 - Low           | Occupational profile & history includes a brief history and review of medical and/<br>or therapy records relating to the presenting problem.   |
|                       | Examination & Performance: Assessments identify 1–3 performance deficits (physical, cognitive or psychosocial) that result in activity limitations or participating restrictions                                       |
|                       | Low complexity clinical decision making, including an analysis of the occupational profile and analysis of data from problem-focused assessments.  |
|                       | No comorbidities that affect occupational performance.   |
|                       | No modification of tasks or assistance was necessary to complete the evaluation.   |
|                       | Consideration of a limited number of treatment options.  |
| 97166 - Moder-<br>ate | Occupational profile & history includes an expanded review of medical and therapy records and additional review of physical, cognitive, or psychosocial history related to current functional performance.             |
|                       | <ul> <li>Examination &amp; performance: Assessments that identify 3-5 performance<br/>deficits (physical, cognitive or psychosocial) that result in activity limitations or<br/>participating restrictions.</li> </ul> |
|                       | <ul> <li>Moderate complexity clinical decision making including an analysis of the<br/>occupational profile and analysis of data from detailed assessments.</li> </ul>   |
|                       | Patient may present with comorbidities that affect occupational performance.   |
|                       | Minimal to moderate modification of tasks or assistance with assessments is necessary to enable completion of evaluation component.  |
|                       | Consideration of several treatment options.  |
| 97167 - High          | Occupational profile & history includes review of medical and therapy records and extensive additional review of physical, cognitive, or psychosocial history related to current functional performance.               |
|                       | Examination & performance: Assessments identify 5 or more performance deficits (physical, cognitive or psychosocial) that result in activity limitations or participating restrictions.                                |
|                       | High complexity clinical decision making including an analysis of the occupational profile and analysis of data from comprehensive assessments.  |
|                       | Patient may present with comorbidities that affect occupational performance.   |
|                       | Significant modification of tasks or assistance with assessments is necessary to enable patient to complete evaluation component.  |
|                       | Consideration of multiple treatment options.   |
