20th annual Infotec attracts 3,000 to conference, show

About 3,000 people attended the 20th annual Infotec '93 conference and product show held by the Ak-Sar-Ben Chapter of the Data Processing Management Association April 26 through 28 at the Holiday Inn Convention Center in Omaha.

A dozen additional seminars were added to the conference portion of the event. About 80 exhibitors displayed products and services at the product show held April 27 and 28.
