

COTTON WEEKLY EXPORT REPORT

USA Upland and Pima Export Sales and Shipments for Week Ending March 13, 2025

- Net current crop sales were 127,600 running bales. Net current crop PLUS new crop sales were 127,600 running bales.
- Current crop sales were down 54% from last week and down 51% from the 4-week average.
- Current PLUS new crop sales were down 62% from last week and down 62% from the 4-week average.
- Shipments were 367,700 running bales,
- Sales for next marketing year total about 1,080,000 (480 lb.) bales. This is 9% of projected 2024/25 exports.
- There are 19 weeks remaining in the 2024/25 marketing year.
- To ship the USDA, WASDE estimate of 11,300,000 (480 lb.) bales for 2024/25crop, the U.S. should average current year sales of 11,900 running bales per week, and needs to average shipments of 253,900 running bales per week.
- Sales were 1070% of the required weekly average. Shipments were 140% of the needed weekly average.

Week Ending 03/13/2025

New Upland Sales for 2024-crop were down this week at 101,100 RB's. Major buyers were Vietnam (73,100), Turkey (18,000), Pakistan (18,300), Mexico (10,600, and Indonesia (4,900). China cancelled 49,300 bales and changed 35,600 bales to Vietnam. New sales of 25-crop of 57,900 bales were reported, mainly to Guatemala (19,200), Bangladesh (9,900), Turkey (8,900), and Mexico (6,600).

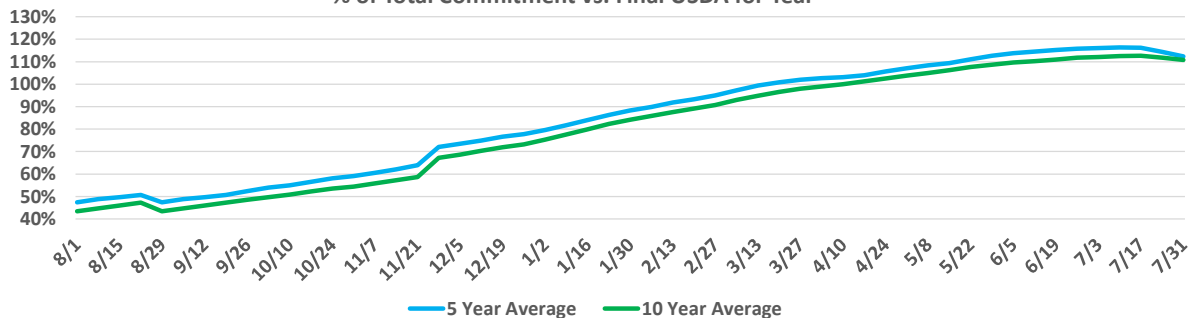
Exports were up, at 351,000 RB's, down from last week. Major destinations included Vietnam (84,900), Pakistan (80,500), Turkey (50,000), and India (24,600).

Pima Sales reported 26,500 total bales sold, a marketing-year high. Main buyers were India (14,200), Peru (4,800), and Pakistan (2,600). Pima exports were 16,700 RBs, also a marketing-year high. Main destinations included China (9,600), India (3,200), and Vietnam (2,300).

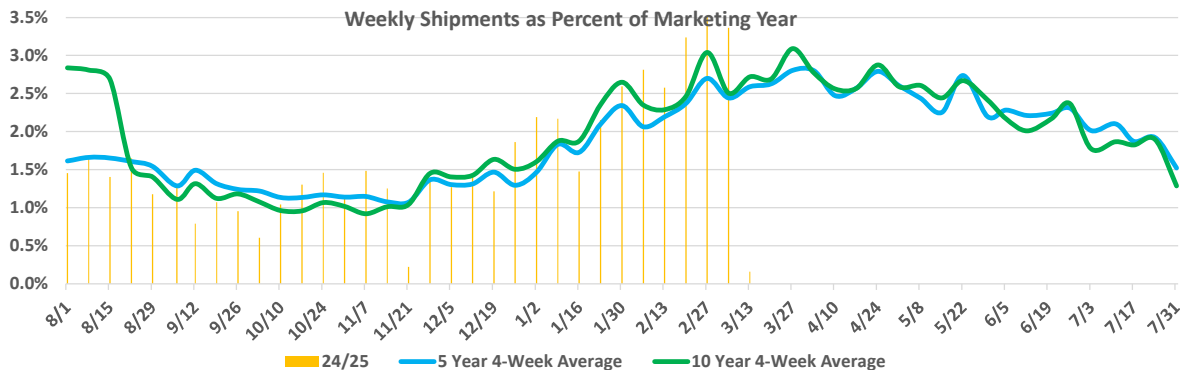
Consignments were unchanged this week. The current global balance is now 4,400 bales in China.

May25 futures were down 53 pts at 6582, about 30 mins after the report.
