<u>Grains closed higher</u> today. Funds were net buyers of 5k soybean contracts, 3k corn contracts and 8k wheat contracts. See page 5 for the current fund positions.

Grains put in a nice performance on the last trading day before Christmas. Markets will be closed Monday 12/26 and resume trade at 9:30 am local time Tuesday. For the week corn closed up 13.25 cents with wheat up 22.5 cents. Export pace for corn continues to lag. <u>USDA did announce flash soybean and corn sales</u> this morning. Weather forecasts in South America are improving while the US faces bitter cold and winter storms. <u>Brazil's largest soybean producing state Mato Grosso</u> has begun early soybean harvest.


