Grains closed sharply lower today and mostly for the week. Funds were net sellers of 30k corn contracts, 30k wheat contracts and 30k soybean contracts. Today money flowed out of commodities and into the equity market. Commodity traders took profits today as "weak longs" sought to limit losses.

The weekly export sales report showed a weekly increase in wheat and corn sales and a decrease in soybean sales. In the daily export reporting system private exporters reported the following: 334,000 MT of soybeans received in the reporting period for delivery to China in MY 2022/23 and 285,000 MT of soybeans for delivery to unknown destinations - 159K MT during MY 2021/22 and 126K MT during MY 2022/23.

Commodity movement in the Black Sea dramatically slowed. Several ships were hit by projectiles over the past couple of days, reflecting the risks for freight being hauled. Ukraine ports are closed, while others remain open, but insurers placed significant premiums on any carriers entering the Black Sea, with many commodity buyers not wanting to take the risk. This has those buyers shopping elsewhere for everything from crude oil, to

wheat, corn, sunflower oil, fertilizer, etc. This is a response to the near-term problem of shipping commodities.




Chart of the Day - March 22 Corn Futures






