Grains closed mixed today. New crop corn and soybeans closed a little higher today. Week-to-week corn, beans and wheat were lower with wheat having the greatest price decline. Funds were net sellers of 6k wheat contracts and even corn and soybeans today. The CFTC COT report showed fund selling for the week. See page 6 for the COT numbers and current estimated fund positions.

The daily export sale announced by FAS this morning was withdrawn based on updated information received from the exporter. FAS-ESR-068-22 had reported the sale of 133,000 metric tons of corn for delivery to China during the 2022/2023 marketing year.


