Grains closed lower today and for the week. Funds were estimated net sellers of 15k corn contracts, 8k wheat contracts and 15k soybean contracts today. Many are asking, why have prices moved the last several days and closed lower for the week. There appear to be several reasons.

- 1. Although rain events in general still are under performing the forecasts, some rains have fallen in the most dry areas pressuring prices.
- 2. Chart patterns have broken to the downside breaking moving average support triggering fund selling.
- 3. The US Dollar Index is trading higher
- 4. Increase in Covid cases in the US and other countries and the situation in Afghanistan causing risk off attitude.

Results from the ProFarmer tour and their US crop estimates support the August USDA WASDE estimates.




