Grains closed lower today. US weather forecasts look more favorable and US planting progress is expected to show a significant increase since last week. USDA announced export sales of 1,020,000 metric tons of corn for delivery to China during the 2021/2022 marketing year and a cancellation of 280,000 tons of corn to China in the 20/21 crop year.

Funds were net sellers of 20k corn, 20k wheat and 2k soybean contracts today. See fund positions on pg 7

The soybean corn ratio (SX21/CZ21) closed today at 2.32

US Weather Forecasts show improving conditions. South American Weather Forecasts are still dry and concerning to Brazil's safrinha corn.



#### **USDA Reports This Week**

On Wednesday May 12, the USDA will release their May WASDE and Crop Production reports. The table summarizes the trade estimates for key data from the USDA reports.

The average trade estimate predicts that the USDA will slightly lower their 2020-21 U.S. carryout numbers for corn, beans, and wheat compared to last month. The largest reduction is in the corn carryout, which the average trade estimate predicts will drop by 77 million bushels (5.7%) compared to last month.

In the USDA's first look at the 2021-22 crop year, traders estimate next year's U.S. corn carryout at 1.344 billion bushels, bean carryout at 138 million bushels, and wheat at 730 million bushels.

The average trade estimate calls for a 46 million bushel increase in the 2021-22 U.S. wheat production estimate compared to last month.

Traders expect the USDA to cut Brazilian corn production by nearly 6 million tons to 103 million tons from the current 109 million ton estimate. Traders also expect a 2 million ton reduction to Argentine corn production and a 2.4 million ton increase to Argentine soybean production.




