<u>Grains closed lower</u> today. Funds were net sellers of 5k corn contracts, 20k soybean and 5k wheat contracts. See page 5 for the current fund positions. Weakness in soy oil futures prompted by the **EPA** biofuels mandate announcement yesterday, improved Argentine weather forecast, long fund soybean position and weak chart technical pressured prices today.

The weekly USDA export sales report came in weak still lagging pace to meet USDA projections. USDA did however announce a flash corn export sale to Mexico today.

The Administration and Congress have worked to avert a US railroad strike.





with Life-of-Contract Highs/Lows







