**Canola Projected Price Discovery Period: Fall Type Projected price discovery period is July 15 – August 14 of the pre-harvest year. Spring Type Projected price discovery period is February 1 – February 28 (February 29 – leap year).							
**Corn for Grain Projected Price Discovery Period: Projected price discovery period is February 1 – February 28 (February 29 – leap year). Corn for Silage Projected Price – A price determined by RMA and released by January 31 of the harvest year.							
**Soybeans Projected Price Discovery Period: Projected price discovery period is February 1 – February 28 (February 29 – leap year).							
**Wheat Projected Price Discovery Period: Winter types projected price discovery period is August 15 – September 14 of the pre-harvest year; Spring types projected price discovery period is February 1 – February 28 (February 29 – leap year).

***Wheat Harvest Price Discovery Period: Harvest price discovery period is August 1 – August 31. The Harvest Price is discovered on the Portland Merchants Exchange soft white wheat contract.							
~Rapeseed prices - Rapeseed is not traded on any Commodity Exchange. However, revenue protection is still considered to be available and the projected and harvest prices will be established by FCIC in accordance with the Commodity Exchange Price Provisions. The result of this action will allow the producer to insure both canola and rapeseed under revenue protection. With both canola and rapeseed insured under revenue protection the producer can qualify for a whole-farm unit. However, rapeseed will not have the benefit of the harvest price moving independent of the projected price as it may for canola. Projected prices for fall and spring types of rapeseed are determined by RMA and released prior to sales closing dates. Harvest price for the applicable type is set equal to the projected price.							
~~Certified Organic Corn (Grain) - For acreage insured as certified organic, the Projected Price and Harvest Price will equal the respective Projected Price and Harvest Price as defined within the Commodity Exchange Price Provisions (CEPP) multiplied by a factor determined by RMA and published on www.rma.usda.gov .

This contract based price election will be determined using the producer's actual contract price.
