As an Agronomy Manager, a typical day may include the following:

- Develop and coordinate agronomy programs, products, and services
- Select and manage product lines to carry and sell including buying inventories, managing inventory levels, and setting prices and programs
- Oversee logistics of delivering and applying agronomical products to our customers
- Manage the overall financial success of the department including setting margins on products, taking positions on commodities, determining capital investment with assistance of upper management and efficiently managing operational costs
- Provide oversight and maintenance of all equipment and facilities utilized by the department through the direction and delegation of the operational and application staff
- Provide support and direction for sales team
- Respond promptly to customer needs and meets commitments
- Identify and resolve problems in a timely manner
- Interpret and enforce laws, rules and regulations governing agricultural seed, chemical, fertilizers and other products handled by the agronomy department
- Supervise agronomy team and builds morale to ensure team meets division's commitments, goals, and objectives
- Work Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Extended hours as needed, especially in spring months
