



Construction Technician

At Waukon Feed Ranch, agriculture and family are the roots of our business. The Construction Technician contributes to our mission by ensuring the success of the Construction Division which ensures that swine facilities are adequately designed, built, repaired, and maintained.

As a Construction Technician, a typical day may include the following:

- New construction, expansions, and repairs and maintenance at swine units including sow farms, nurseries, and finishing sites
- Work on equipment including but not limited to feed motors, feed sensors, control troubleshooting, feed augers, feed pipes, fan motors for wall and pit fans, fan housing, water, gas and pressure washer lines, curtains and inlets, and cool cells
- Roof repairs and replacements
- Welding to repair and construct gating and pens
- Completing structural building repairs, doors and framing, slat patching
- Follow all required bio-security including showering in and out of facilities, disinfecting tools, having proper downtime as assigned by Construction Management
- Spend equal time both indoors and outdoors, depending on the project assigned
- Must have valid driver's license. You will be assigned to a company vehicle to get to work sites.
- Ability to keep track of tasks completed throughout the day and fill out log of daily activities.
- Must have a smart phone for work order dispatching and time clock keeping.

This job might be for you if:

- You are adaptable and can deal with frequent changes, delays, or unexpected events
- You meet commitments and deadlines
- You have strong prioritization and communication skills
- You are mechanically inclined and have a good operational sense
- You can lift a minimum of 50 pounds
- You can be on your feet for 10 hours a day, lift, pull, push, bend, kneel, squat, grasp tools and equipment
- You can work in farm environments
- You can work well with others and work in teams of two or more.

- High school diploma preferred. Experience with construction or maintenance is preferred. Welding experience preferred.
