



Gilt Developer Unit (GDU) Caretaker

As a GDU Caretaker, a typical day may include the following:

- Shipping and receiving animals
- Identifying sick animals and treating them
- Moving/sorting animals with a sorting board
- Cleaning facilities including power-washing
- Keeping detailed, accurate records that comply with Holden Farms
- Ensuring all animals are receiving proper feed, water, and ventilation
- Understand and follow biosecurity protocol, must shower in and out of the facility
- Must be able to work 1-2 hours each day doing chores (this could be in the morning or evening, flexible options)
- Must be available to load an average of 2 loads onto a truck each month, load times vary, typically in morning around 6:00 a.m.

This job might be for you if:

- You put animal welfare at the forefront, making sure all animals are well taken care of
- You like to be physically active
- You are punctual and dependable
- You communicate well both written and verbally
- You are available to work 1-2 hours a day, 7 days a week (time off can be scheduled with barn owners)
