- Answer the phone in a professional manner and respond to customer's questions and/or direct calls to the appropriate personnel
- Work at our grain dump as needed to dump customers' commodities in the appropriate area
- Be able to work various hours during harvest (September – November), WFR can schedule you as you are available
- Position will be at the Agronomy Center and the Feed Mill, depending on needs for the day
