**As a Swine Intern, a typical day may include the following:**

- Work on a special project that is tailored to your interest- people management, public relations, nutrition, pig production, etc.
- Shipping and receiving animals
- Treating animals
- Heat checking and breeding sows and gilts
- Assisting with the birthing process of sows and gilts
- Caring for piglets and ensuring they are off to a good start
- Moving animals with a sorting board
- Cleaning facilities including power-washing
- Keeping detailed, accurate records that comply with integrator
- Ensuring all animals are receiving proper feed, water, and ventilation
- Understand and follow WFR's biosecurity protocol, must shower in and out of the facility
