2023 Harvest Policy

Effective September 1st, 2023

Corn

Corn will be shrunk to 15% to sell and 14% to store. Shrink factor will be 1.30% per point of moisture.

Storage is 18¢ to January 1st, 2024 then 3.5¢ per month, .0012 cents per day thereafter.

Soybeans

Storage is 20¢ until January 1st, 2023 then 3.5¢ per month, .0012 cents per day thereafter.

Soybeans will be shrunk 1.5% per half point to 13% on a load by load basis.

Carryover Grain

Any unpriced grain after September 1st, 2023 will incur a daily storage rate of .0012 cents until the grain is sold with no new minimum charges.

If possible please notify the office what you wish to do with grain prior to delivery.

Each load is given 7 days before it is placed into storage.
