Post-Secondary Education Scholarship for 2025

Seibert Equity Educational Fund is committed to supporting students and providing opportunities to continue their education. This Post-Secondary Education Scholarship is meant to provide financial assistance for students pursuing higher education. This Application, along with all required attachments, must be submitted by the deadline of April 11, 2025.

Scholarship amounts will be granted to recipients based on availability of funds. Four types of scholarship eligibility are available under this Application:

- 1. One-time scholarship to be awarded to student(s) <u>beginning</u> a four-year diploma or degree program at an accredited post-secondary institution.
- 2. One-time scholarship to be awarded to student(s) <u>beginning</u> a two-year diploma, degree, or certificate program at an accredited post-secondary institution.
- 3. One-time scholarship to be awarded to student(s) that <u>has completed at least two years</u> of a four-year diploma or degree program at an accredited post-secondary institution.
- 4. One-time scholarship to be awarded to student(s) that will be attending an accredited Vocational or Technical College.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Any person seeking one of the four scholarships described above who resides in the counties of Cheyenne, Elbert, Kiowa, Kit Carson, Lincoln, Washington, or Yuma, Colorado may apply.

Contributing Factors: Applications will be reviewed based on multiple factors:

- a) Academic performance in high school or a prior post-secondary institution (please attach any and all supporting transcripts)
- b) Community service/involvement
- c) Leadership potential and qualities
- d) Written essay addressing the topic of "What influence has rural America had on your life and how will you impact Agriculture in the future" 500 words or less.
- e) One **letter of recommendation** from previous teachers, counselors, or supervisors

<u>Awards of Scholarships</u>: Announcements of scholarship awards for recipient students <u>beginning</u> their higher education will be made at the student's high school graduation or awards ceremony, if possible. Otherwise, recipients will be notified in writing no later than June 1st. Funds will not be distributed until a letter of acceptance or proof of enrollment is supplied. In all cases, funds will be distributed directly to the institution.
