## **Semi Driver**

### **Primary Duties and Responsibilities:**

- I. **General Duties** – including, but not be limited to the following:
  - A. Grain Semi Driver and all other Grain handling (including drying) - Logistics
  - B. Blending, loading and delivery of bulk fertilizers – Dry or Liquid
  - C. Handling bulk and packaged crop protection products – Sprayer Tender
  - D. Seed Delivery- Seed warehouse
  - E. Opportunity for propane sales and delivery
  - F. Perform other duties not listed in this description as required by management.
- II. **Safety**
  - A. Maintain any company equipment used in the performance of your job in good physical and mechanical condition
  - B. Operate equipment in a safe manner and in compliance with all OSHA, state and federal regulations. Adhere to all company safety policies.
  - C. Communicate safe storage and handling procedures to all customers
  - D. Attend Right-to-Know, safety, and anhydrous ammonia training as required.
- III. **Certification**
  - A. Maintain Class A CDL (HazMat and Tanker)
  - B. Will attain and maintain Handlers Certification minimum.
  - C. Commercial Applicators licensing. (Core, 1A, 1B, other)
- IV. **Efficiency**
  - A. Perform duties in an efficient manner so that excessive overtime is not required by yourself or others in the company
  - B. Dependability - Positive attitude – Communication – Teamwork – Confidentiality
  - C. Overtime required during spring planting and fall harvest – weekends included
  - D. Perform other duties not listed in this description as required by management.
- V. **Other Duties**
  - A. It is to be understood that you may be required to work at all North Iowa Cooperative locations or other job sites as required by management. A new hire is subject to an introductory period of 90 days before permanent hiring and finalization of drug screen and background check.
