Feeding Equine Junior Horse Feed with forage Equine Junior Horse Feed is designed to be fed as a complete feed. If necessary, you may also feed with good-quality hay or pasture - up to a maximum of 5.0 pounds per day - to relieve boredom. You should reduce the amount of Equine Junior Horse Feed fed by 1.0 lb for every 1.5 - 2.0 lbs of hay offered. A minimum of 6.0 lbs of Equine Junior Horse Feed should be fed per day to meet minimum daily requirements of protein, vitamins and minerals. For best results, do not feed more than 1.0 lb of hay per 100 lbs of your horse's body weight when feeding Equine Junior Horse Feed.

### IMPORTANT

- Any feed changes should be made gradually over a period of 7 to 10 days. Changes in the rate of feeding should not exceed 1.0 lb per day for each horse. Feed at regular times - at least twice daily with three daily feedings preferred. Be sure to weigh your feed using a scale. A small scale can be purchased in the fishing department of many sporting goods stores.
- Reduce and/or delay feeding a horse which is hot, excited or showing pain, has fever or diarrhea. Consult your veterinarian if any problems arise. Prevent rapid eating.
- Let horses feed in natural position from large feed containers.
- Have plenty of fresh, clean water available at all times.
- Store in a dry, well-ventilated area protected from rodents and insects. Do not feed moldy or insect-infested feed to animals as it may cause illness or death.
- Observe horses daily. Consult your veterinarian for proper preventative health care. Maintain a regular deworming and vaccination program.
- Be sure that your horses are free of dental problems.
- Feeding added selenium resulting in total diet levels exceeding 0.3 ppm is prohibited.

### CAUTION

Store in a dry, well-ventilated area protected from rodents and insects. Do not feed moldy or insect-infested feed to animals as it may cause illness, abortion or death.
