


Market Summary

Wheat futures are trading higher this morning, up 1 to 7 cents in the *DECEMBER* futures. Pretty quiet morning again and current Sww prices have held at \$6.85 for a number of days now kind as a placeholder until something happens to change it. Sounds like current price levels are still getting enough grain bought for now. The weekly export sales report came out this morning and shipments came in at the middle or upper middle of the range of estimates. That sounds pretty good but the expectations for wheat were pretty low to start with. Ukraine is shipping out of their black sea ports and there haven't been any hiccups aside from some small damage from a mine early on. Tensions in the middle east with Isreal are affecting energy markets mainly, but there is a "major" announcement coming tonight from the Biden that could potentially be interesting. Doesn't look like a lot of trading activity on the futures markets so maybe the trade isn't too worried about it.


A drier weather pattern is forecast for NE Brazil into early next week. Weather models are turning drier in parts of Argentina. The GFS model is wetter in western and central areas of Argentina. Above average presipitation is forecast for many of the major U.S. growing areas in the 6-10 and 8-14 day forecasts. If realized we may see harvest delays.

<u>Cash Futures Prices</u>: Chicago **DEC** is up 7 at 587. KC **DEC** is up 1 at 671 and MPLS **DEC** is up 1 at 735. US Dollar is trading 0.41 lower at 106.16.
