Local Daily Commentary

April 25, 2023 Market Email:

Local Commentary care of Cory Christianson NWGG

Nothing positive for grain markets so far on the day, and they all continue to slide with HRW and soybeans leading the way down and hard. Momentum for all of the markets we watch is firmly negative now and it seems bullish news items get swallowed up within 20-30 minutes. Crude oil is down \$2 and finding support at \$76.50/barrel and the US\$ Index is up sharp to 1.015.

Yesterday afternoon's Crop Progress report essentially landed exactly where trade had projected it would. Winter wheat conditions, on the whole, declined very slightly. Corn and soybean planting progress is moving along nicely except for the Dakotas. Spring wheat planting is way behind and will likely continue to lag. Your obligatory reminder here than Midwestern farmers can plant several million acres of crop per week so long as they have a little window in their weather.

And From CHS Hedging

Wheat

- Minneapolis wheat is slightly higher while KC and Chicago are slightly lower.
- Ukrainian wheat production is expected to fall nearly 40% with exports falling an estimated 6mmt from the current marketing year.
- Wheat conditions fell to 26% good to excellent.
- The forecast has much of Kansas and Oklahoma receiving significant rainfall.
- Chi May 23 is dn 2 ½, at \$6.41, Mpls May 23 is up 1, at \$8.43 ¾, and KC May 23 is dn 5 ¾, at \$8.27 ¼.

Outlook: The trend for all three U.S. wheats is lower as prices continue to look for support and weather forecasts have improved.

Mostly Red Wheat Market for Tuesday Trade

So far for Tuesday the wheat market is trading red across the winter wheats, while MPLS wheat is fractionally to 2 cents stronger. Chicago wheat led the complex lower with double digit losses on Monday. May SRW fell by 18 1/4 cents on the day, while the other nearbys were 10 to 16 cents weaker. Preliminary open interest dropped 4,800 contracts, with May shedding 10,913 after options expired. KC HRW futures settled down by 7 3/4 to 8 1/2 cents across the front months. MPLS futures ended with Monday losses of 1 3/4 to 6 1/4 cents.

Weekly Crop Progress data showed 5% of the spring wheat crop was planted compared to the average pace of 12%. 1% of that has emerged. Winter wheat was 18% headed as of 4/23. That is 4% points ahead of average. Winter wheat conditions slipped 3 points on the Brugelr500 Index to a 270.

Converted NASS data showed the South Dakota winter wheat crop fell the most through the week from 309 to a 272. Conditions in OK also fell another 20 points to 211 on the Brugler500 scale, the lowest reading of the tracked states. KS was the 2nd lowest reading as of 4/23 at a 222 on the Brugler500.

Weekly Inspections data showed 363,826 MT of wheat exports for the week that ended 4/20. The weekly data had the season's total shipment at 17.866 MMT, or 2.8% behind last year's pace.

Ahead of the StatsCan acreage estimates report, due Wednesday, analysts are looking for a 1m acre increase for wheat to 26.3m on average. The full range is for between 25.5m acres to 27 million, compared to 25.4m last season. Spring wheat specifically is expected to increase 900k acres on average to 18.9 million.
