


## **Market Summary**


Wheat futures are trading mixed this morning, down 3 to up 9 cents in the *DECEMBER* futureswith CHI SRW being the strongest. Yesterday's futures seemed to ignore a bullish Production outlook from StatsCAN for Canadian crops and condinued lower. Canadian wheat production forecasted at 29.5 MMT which is the second lowest in 8 years, and down 14% from last year. The estimate fell below the average industry expectation of 30.4 MMT. Wheat futures prices rebounded in the evening session and into this morning. Have we seen the bottom? Hopefully the low prices have attracted some business and the markets can climb out of the depths. Russia and Turkey are in talks to re-setablish a Black Sea grain shipping agreement that was cancelled in mid-July. Egypt put out an international wheat tender and rumors are the French have the lowest bid at \$259.42/MT (about \$7.06/bu) for 60,000 MT. Russia again has stuck to its guns and refused to lower their bid from their unofficial \$270/MT self-imposed minimum price.

<u>December Chicago wheat futures made new lows in yesterday's trade but have rebounded in the overnight and early morning trade</u>. Currently seeing CHI SRW Dec23 at \$6.07 3/4. Resistance on the chart is figured in at 6.43 1/2 to 6.46 1/4 with a secondary level of resistance at 6.77 1/4 to 6.82 1/4. Support levels on the chart are figured at 599 1/2 which is the low from yesterday's trading.

<u>Cash Futures Prices:</u> Chicago **DEC** is up 7 at 608. KC **DEC** is up 1 at 731 and MPLS **DEC** is down 3 at 782. US Dollar is trading 0.40 lower at 103.13.
