# Nitrogen Management Tools - Neon Air

Best management practices for nitrogen along with nutrient stewardship continue to be a hot topic of discussion. The use of nitrogen stabilizers, enhanced efficiency fertilizers, and biological products remain a very viable and achievable strategy when continuing nitrogen management conversations.

During the 'Maximizing Your Nitrogen Dollar 2022 Webinar Series' presented by OMAFRA, Craig Drury presented results from several studies showing the impact that both the application method (broadcast, side dress, or injection) and inclusion of a nitrogen stabilizer on N based fertilizers can have on yields and nitrous oxide (NO<sub>2</sub>) emissions. They showed a positive yield advantage on corn with an 8 bu/acre increase by including a stabilizer on urea along with a 30-50% reduction in NO<sub>2</sub> emissions. The highest reduction in losses was found when liquid nitrogen was injected into the ground vs untreated urea being broadcast ahead of planting. #### Lambda-cyhalothrin Pesticide Label Update

Under the Pest Control Products Act, all registered pesticides must be re-evaluated by Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) to ensure that they continue to meet current health and environmental standards, while continuing to provide value. The re-evaluation considers data and information from pesticide manufacturers, published scientific reports and other regulatory agencies, as well as comments received during public consultations. Among others the active ingredient Lambda-cyhalothrin which is a synthetic pyrethroid insecticide used to control a broad range of insect pests on a wide variety of crops, has been reviewed and as a result carries an amended label for 2023.

Growers will be familiar with trade names such as Matador, Silencer, Labamba, Endigo, and Voliam Xpress which all contain the Lambda-cyhalothrin active ingredient. Uses of this chemistry have been cancelled on a variety of crops including all crops intended for feed uses, lettuce, mustard seed, and bulb vegetables (see the official Re-evaluation decision document on the Government of Canada's website for the full list of crops). From an agronomic perspective, we are fortunate to have alternative insecticides for growers in 2023 depending on the crop type. These options often bring better value to growers in terms of residual value, safety of pollinators, and better efficacy particularly under higher heat and humidity conditions where Lambda-chyalothrin has historically had downfalls.
