



GRAIN STORAGE, CORN AND SOYBEAN DRYING PROGRAM AND DISCOUNT SCHEDULE

1. When unloading grain, the **driver** is responsible to tell whoever scales the load:

- A. Who owns the grain and
- B. Is this a **spot (cash)** sale or is the grain **contracted**?

2. Soybeans will be accepted up to 13.5% moisture. Soybeans testing 13.6% or higher will be at the discretion of the elevator. The Almena elevator dries soybeans and is an alternative location for wet soybeans.

3. Grain storage and grain bank deficiencies are not allowed and will be billed monthly based on the price the day of shortage.

4. Daily storage is calculated per day at a rate of \$.00131416 (\$.04 per month) for corn and soybeans.

5. Handling Charges

- A. **Wet corn in-charge** (at or above 15.0% moisture) – **NO in-charge.**
- B. **Dry corn in-charge** (testing less than 14.9% or less) - \$.06 per bushel, (unless sold at time of delivery).
- C. **Soybean in-charge** - \$.06 per bushel (unless sold at time of delivery).
- D. **Out charge for all grain** - \$.10 per bushel, unless used in Synergy feed mixes or marketed through Synergy.

6. Discounts will be taken for foreign matter, damage and test weight.

7. Due to volatile fuel prices, drying surcharges may fluctuate dependent on fuel prices at the time of drying.

8. Synergy maintains a **zero tolerance for treated soybeans**. Any delivery which yields a sample containing treated soybeans may be subject to one or all of the following:

- A. No payment for the entire load.
- B. **Punitive charges for contamination of all affected soybean inventory.**
- C. Further financial liability dependent on severity of contaminated soybeans.

9. **Cameron location traffic policy:** All traffic entering and leaving our property must do so by way of County Road SS to the east. All vehicles must adhere to this policy whether delivering or picking up grain.

10. We reserve the right to direct and funnel grain to the facility that we see fit depending on available storage capacity at each location. We also may require that **inbound dry corn** be delivered to one of Synergy's feed mills.

11. For corn over 28% moisture, arrangements should be made to dry **after peak season**. No corn over 32% or under 48 lb. test weight will be accepted for drying or storage. Please call and make arrangements before bringing corn in. We reserve the right to refuse grain based on quality concerns.
