Wheat Harvest 2021

We will be handling wheat at the Meadows, Pontiac, and Sunbury elevators. We would like to get Farm I.D. information set up prior to harvest. Please call the Weston office if you plan on hauling to any of these elevators or have any questions.

There will be 30 days Free DP after the last date of unload on the grain sheet to sell the wheat. If the wheat is not sold by the close of business on the 30th day, it will be placed into the delayed price program.

Delayed Price: 20 cent minimum thru September 15, 2021 then 3.0 cents per bushel per month prorated daily thru June 30, 2022 then all new rates apply.

Storage: Not Available

1. Please inform the scale operator of the proper Farm I.D. for the wheat. Advise the scale operator when a delivery sheet is finished.
2. We will send a copy of the delivery sheet after we have been advised that the delivery sheet has been completed and grades are finalized.
3. Depending on the overall quality of this year's harvest, wheat samples may be submitted to an independent Grain Inspection Service for grading or testing. This may delay final settlement and payment.
4. If no activity on a delivery sheet for 14 days, it will be suspected of being finished.

Soft Red Winter Wheat Discount Schedule

Test Weight:	5¢ each ½ pound 57.9 pounds to 56.0 pounds 10¢ each ½ pound 55.9 pounds to 54.0 pounds 15¢ each ½ pound 53.9 pounds to 52.0 pounds 20¢ each ½ pound below 52.0 but subject to rejection	
Moisture:	5 ¢ each ½% or fraction above 13.5%. Moisture over 15% subject to rejection	
Damage:	4¢ each 1% or fraction above 4.0% to 7.0% 6¢ each 1% or fraction above 7.0% to 10.0%	
Dockage:	To be deducted from gross weight	
Vomitoxin:	No discount 0.0 to 2.0 ppm 15¢ each 1 ppm from 2.1 and above Above 5.0 - Subject to rejection
