## Other Grade Factors:

Heat Damage: 1.0 cents/bu for each 1/10 of 1% over 0.2%. Over 1.0% subject to rejection.

Aflatoxin/Vomitoxin/other toxins: Over 0 subject to rejection. Contact Nugen prior to delivery if toxins are suspected.

Corn that is musty, sour, infested, or contains a commercially objectable foreign odor is subject to rejection. If accepted discount will be at least 10 cents/bushel.

Loads containing animal refuse, stones, glass, or other commercially undesirable foreign material will be rejected.

Loads containing snow, ice, or large chunks of grain that do not break up are subject to rejection. If accepted discount may be up to 20 cents/bushel

Any load with above .5% of other grains or soybeans is subject to rejection. If accepted discount will be .6 cents per 1/10th of 1% over .2%.

Each load is graded and discounted on its own merit. No averaging.

We reserve the right to reject any load for unacceptable quality.

We may retain samples of questionable grain and have them submitted for official grades from a grain inspection agency. These grades will supercede our initial grades

## Final Notes

All corn delivered to NuGen Energy without a contract to apply to will be spot priced at the closing bid on the day of delivery.

NuGen Energy will send checks on Tuesday and Thursday of each week for corn delivered prior to that day.

All grain and contract splits between producer and landlords need to be done prior to delivery. Corn that is under loan must be communicated that it is under loan, in which case the loan will be paid off to the respective FSA office, and the balance will go to the producer.
