If the order is filled, your sale is complete. Orders will need to be placed with the coop by 4:45 PM. 1,000 bu minimum

FORWARD SALE AND DELIVERY CONTRACTS CAN BE MADE DURING THE TRADING SESSION AT YOUR LOCAL ELEVATOR.

Example: if you want to sell bushels that you know will be harvested over the weekend, you can make a contract and price those at anytime during the trading session. Delivery will need to be made by July 15th.

15 DAY GRACE PERIOD ON STORAGE CHARGES. THEREAFTER, STORAGE REVERTS BACK TO DAY OF DEPOSIT.
