- If you are visiting one of our retail sites or agronomy service centers, please limit your time and interaction on site and remain within those areas designated for customer foot traffic.
- If you need to pick up a grain check, sign a contract, or pay a bill, please call ahead and make arrangements so your time on site can be minimized.
- All non-essential visitors (non-customers) are restricted from visiting our locations until further notice. This protects both the Staff and You, Our Customer!
