ACROSS THE SCALE GRAIN PURCHASES WILL ONLY BE MADE DURING THE TRADING SESSION BETWEEN 8:30 AM AND 1:00 PM OFFERS CAN BE GIVEN TO YOUR LOCAL ELEVATOR FOR THE OVER NIGHT TRADING SESSION.

Example: You want to sell bushels that were harvested after the market close. Give your local coop the quantity and price you want, and the order will be placed in the overnight session. If the order is filled, your sale is complete. Orders will need to be placed with the coop by 4:45 PM.

FORWARD SALE AND DELIVERY CONTRACTS CAN BE MADE DURING THE TRADING SESSION AT YOUR LOCAL ELEVATOR.

Example: if you want to sell bushels that you know will be harvested over the weekend, you can make a contract and price those at anytime during the trading session. Delivery will need to be made by July 15th.

15 DAY GRACE PERIOD ON STORAGE CHARGES. THEREAFTER, STORAGE REVERTS BACK TO DAY OF DEPOSIT.

STORAGE RATE 164.4/1000 CENTS PER BUSHELS PER DAY (60.01 CENTS PER BUSHELS PER YEAR)

Samples sent to KGIS for Offical grade will supercede local grades. Samples may be sent at Buyers request for any reason.
