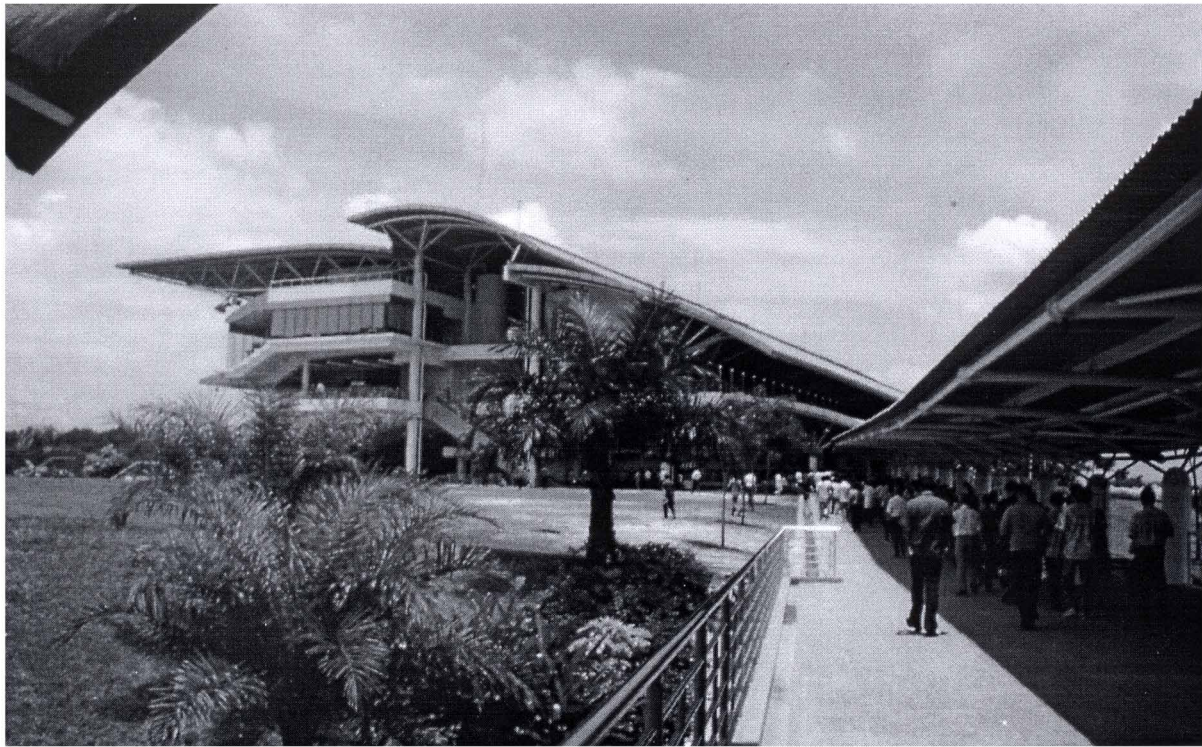

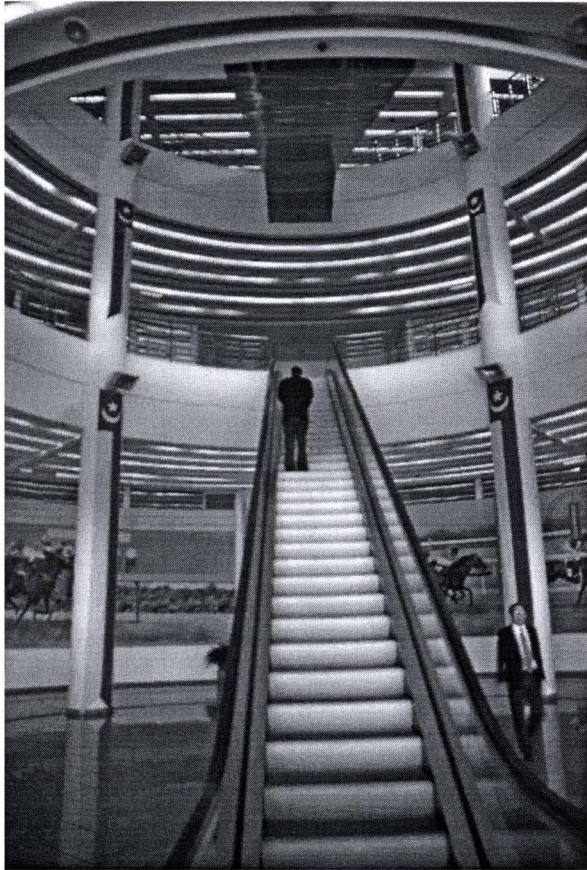


*Above: A covered walkway leads from the ticketing hall to the public entrance of the grandstand on the north end. The large, steel truss, overhang roof protects the spectators from the sun.*

*Left: A private, west entrance for club members leads to a circular lobby where an escalator connects to a first floor restaurant.*

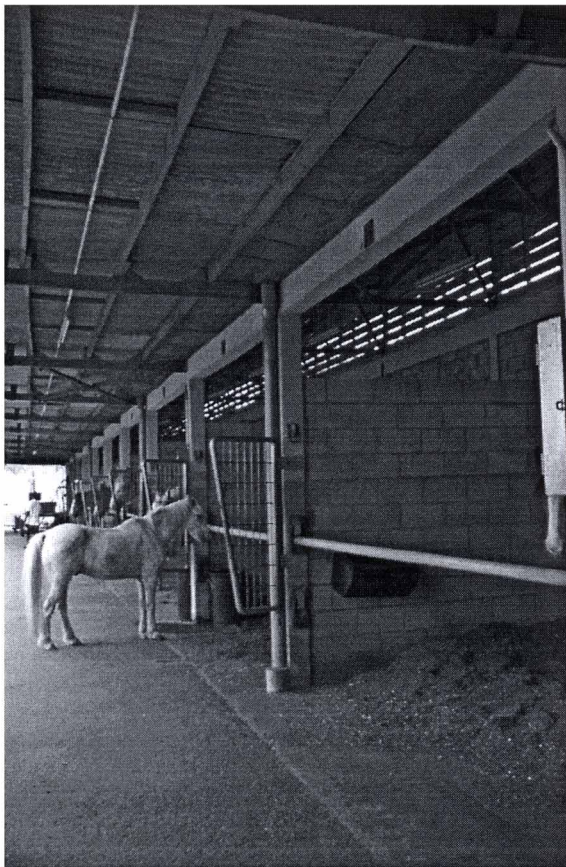
*Below: The parade ring directly in front of the grandstand faces the 2'000 metre turf racing track.*
