






Above: A covered walkway leads from the ticketing hall to the public entrance of the grandstand on the north end. The large, steel truss, overhang roof protects the spectators from the sun.

Left: The Chinese restaurant on the upper floor looks down an atrium to the fast food court, which can accommodate 600 people. The open design maximises cross-ventilation.




Left: A private, west entrance for club members leads to a circular lobby where an escalator connects to a first floor restaurant.

Above: The steel-frame truss roof sits on a reinforced concrete structural frame. The roofs are split into various sections and incorporate louvres to allow for cross-ventilation and hot air to escape.
