The Tabib House with Bousheh's vernacular architecture belongs to the Qajar period. Its total area is 595 m² and its built area 1100 m¹. The A'lam House of the Talle-Asheqan neighbor-hood in Esfahan goes back to the Qajar period (19th century A.D.). The built area of the house is 1118 m² and the court-yard 798 m². The different kinds of isolation have been used in this house. The first storey is made of brick, the second one of adobe.
