The design of the university is based on two important features of Iranian urbanism: the bazaar and the courtyard. The 'bazaar' is a pedestrian way placed at the centre of the university, and the buildings placed around it take their inspiration from the 'Khan Madrassa', which was designed as two intertwining courts. The architecture makes use of elements such as the canopy, the porch and the terrace to counter the effects of the hot and dry climate.

Foundation of the architectural idea is based on two local patterns; Bazaar and courtyard. Bazaar, as a pedestrian way, is placed in centerof university. Other spaces are place around it.

The layout of spaces is a conception of "khan Madrassa" which was designedas two interwined court.

Adaption of canopy, porch, terrace in first floor, and in general a solid architecture, considering hot and dry climate, are some of this project characteristic.
