Village comprises 120 houses arranged in groups of 4





10 masons trained in construction techniques. Mud bricks stabilised with 6% concrete.



Each houses has private courtyard to maintain traditional organisation



Access from “street” to private courtyard of each house



Entrance courtyard of one house





Government controllers set up laboratory on site to ensure strength of mud brick structures



Stabilised mud bricks made by hand at first; later by machine press





Rentable formwork used for vaults
