During the Mungole Capmaign which is lead by TAYMOOR, the Hammam was subject to destruction at I40I, then it was restored at I4I7 by the governor of Aleppo: Al-Amir Sayf Aldin Yelbogha al-Nassiri.

It is one of the most beautiful Hammam of the city, and now it is in good situation. It is located near the gate of Aleppo citadel and the Palace of Justice.

Formerly, it was changed to a small factory, then at 1980, it was been restored rehabilitated from the Ministry of Tourism in order to be a public touristic bath.
