



Background

The **Right Road Job Training and Placement Program** is a partnership/joint-effort between ATSSA and FailSafe-ERA.

The training is designed to improve resiliency, social adaptability, family, and societal reintegration – and to encourage successful employment outcomes for returning citizens.

First pilot program/class – **APRIL 1-5, 2019**

The Right Road Job Training and Placement Program is a cognitive-behavioral, skills-building program. (*Details in a moment.*)

The program challenges transitioning inmates and returning citizens to change their beliefs and behaviors.

Background

This is accomplished, in part, through structured group discussions.

The curriculum challenges transitioning inmates and returning citizens to change their long-term beliefs and behaviors.

Participants are challenged to examine how their behavior choices have been caused by their emotions, thoughts and beliefs.

The program is 40-hours (in classroom).

Following the classroom training, the returning citizen will receive ATSSA Flagger Training for job placement in the roadway safety industry at an ATSSA-member company.

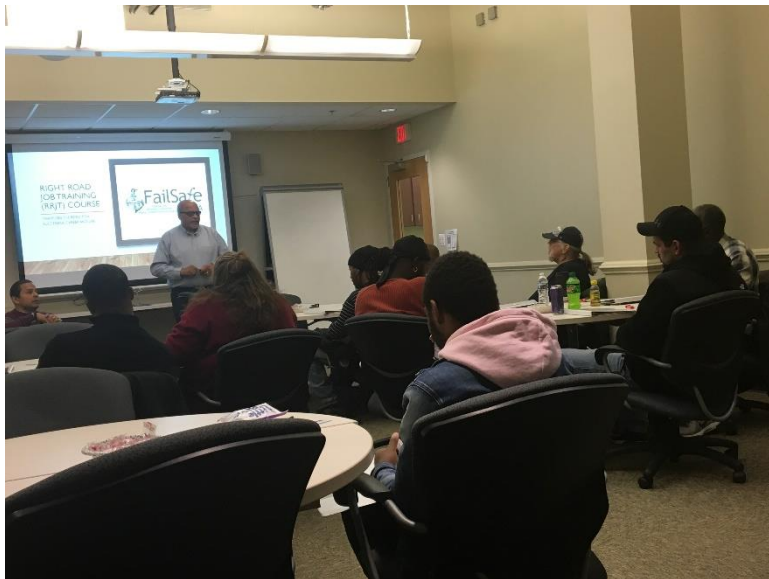
Follow up

FailSafe-ERA personnel will provide a **minimum of six-months of mentoring to returning citizens who have completed the training program** and who have received successful placement.

The mentoring component of the program is to **support the returning citizen's transition to their communities**

- Encourages them to remain focused on their reentry goals, with the overall goal to be productive and contributing citizens.
- Structured peer mentoring program where the alumni will serve as mentors, with FailSafe-ERA staff oversight.
