Winter Tips & Tricks for Hearing Aid Maintenance

Cold weather can take a toll on hearing aids, but with a few simple habits, you can keep them performing their best all season long.



First, protect your devices from moisture. Snow, rain, and condensation can damage microphones and battery contacts. Keep a small umbrella or hat handy, and remove your hearing aids before heading out into heavy weather. At night, store them in a dry-aid kit or dehumidifier to prevent corrosion and distortion.

Second, watch out for temperature extremes. Batteries can drain faster in the cold, so carry spares when you're outdoors. Let your hearing aids return to room temperature before changing batteries or opening compartments—this reduces condensation buildup inside.

Third, handle scarves, hats, and hoods carefully. Fabric rubbing against your ears can cause feedback or dislodge the devices. Opt for snug but breathable materials and check your fit before leaving the house.

Finally, schedule a quick winter checkup with your hearing care professional. A mid-season cleaning and performance test can ensure your devices are ready for the holidays—so you can focus on what matters most: family gatherings, laughter, and all the sounds of the season.
