Drop Off/Pick Up Procedure

Please drive your vehicle to the north side of the parking lot and follow the cones. Parents and children will stay in the car. A CCC staff member will greet your child and ask if your child or anyone in the household has been ill in the last 48 hours. Each camper will have their temperature taken with a contactless thermometer. To keep others healthy, your child will not be allowed to attend camp if he/she has a temperature above 100 degrees. Please help us keep all of our campers, volunteers, and staff healthy by keeping children home if anyone in the home has been sick with a fever, vomiting, diarrhea, cough, etc.

After getting temperature checked, your child will exit the car and walk on the sidewalk to the outdoor play area.

Pick Up will happen in the same location as drop off. Parents will remain in the car at all times.
