Discuss Guide

Discuss:

- Read each of the seven "I Am" statements in <u>John 6:35</u> (bread), <u>8:12</u> (light), <u>10:7</u> (door), <u>10:11</u> (Good Shepherd), <u>11:25</u> (Resurrection), <u>14:6</u> (Way, Truth, Life), <u>15:1</u> (True Vine).
- The Hebrew name for God is YHWH. Translated it is "I AM." What are the implications of Jesus' claim in John 8:58 (Read 8:54-59)?
- What are the characteristics of sheep you see in yourself or others around you?
- Read <u>1 Peter 5:4</u>. To those who tend to a flock of sheep, what is God's promise to his faithful shepherds?
- Jesus claimed to be the good shepherd. What do bad shepherds do? <u>Ezekiel</u> 34 has a good description, what is your personal experience?
- What are the wolves in your life that you need a Good Shepard to protect you?
- In your past, share of a time where God comforted you when you were being attacked by a wolf?

Other Passages:

- Psalm 95:7 "For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand."
- Isaiah 40:11 "He will tend his flock like a shepherd; he will gather the lambs in his arms."
- Here are other passages where Yahweh is a shepherd.
 - Genesis 48:15; Psalms 28:9; 78:52; 79:13; 80:1; 107:41; Ecclesiastes
 12:11; Isaiah 40:11; Jeremiah 31:10; Ezekiel 34:15; Zechariah 9:16

Apply:

• Ashley identified four ways that Jesus is a good shepherd: He is present, He guides, He provides, He pursues. Which of these is most important to you right now?

- Jesus said his sheep hear his voice. What area of your life do you need to listen to him more carefully?
- Read <u>Revelation 3:20</u>. The Good Shepherd is always there for us, what do we need to do this week to hear his voice and open the door?
- What are ways that we can allow our Good Shepard to "make me lie down in green pastures?" Is there a way we as a group can help make that happen?

Prayer:

Read aloud together <u>Psalm 23</u> as a prayer. Have one-person close, thanking God for being such a good shepherd and identifying 2-3 attributes of his care for us.
