

Indoor Worship - What to Expect

Arrival time

Please arrive early to allow time for check-in and seating. Seating will begin 15 minutes prior to the start of service.

What to expect when you arrive for indoor worship service:

- Facemasks are required and are to be worn covering nose and mouth. (masks are available if needed)
- Social distancing is in practice.
- Please park in the front parking lot and maintain 6 ft. social distance from others.
- Follow the signs for one-way foot traffic to ENTER and EXIT the building (ENTER door is on the right).
- Once you enter the building, please use hand sanitizer and maintain social distancing while in line for the Check-in table.
- After check-in, you will be directed to a worship center door and an usher will seat you.
- Each household unit sits together; household chair groupings are spaced to maintain social distance.
- No congregational singing at this time.
- Once the service has concluded, attendees will exit by row as directed by the ushers.

Personal Health Assessment

Please note: If you answer yes to **any** of these questions, please stay home.

1. Are you currently experiencing, or have you in the last 14 days experienced, any symptoms such as fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, body aches or muscle pain, sore throat, headache, diarrhea, nausea/vomiting, runny nose, or new loss of taste or smell?
2. Have you been in close contact (less than six feet) in the last 14 days with any persons who have been diagnosed with COVID-19 or were experiencing any symptoms listed in question 1?
3. Have you been advised by a healthcare provider to self-quarantine due to COVID-19?
4. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
5. Are you currently waiting on the results of a COVID-19 test?
6. Have you traveled internationally in the past 10 days?
