What to Expect – In Person Worship Effective through June 2021

As COVID restrictions are changing and the rate of community spread continues in a downward trend, we want to help people feel comfortable in returning to in-person worship and also to gradually take steps to return to our pre-COVID worship experience.

Mask Guidelines

- Masks are welcome
- Masks for vaccinated individuals are optional
- If you have not been vaccinated we ask that you kindly wear a mask
- When social distancing is not possible, unvaccinated people are encouraged to wear a mask
- Worship seating offers more familiar seating options
 - Center seats are arranged in rows that are spaced 6 feet apart. This allows fully vaccinated people to sit next to other households if they choose to do so
 - o If you want to maintain social distancing in the row seating, simply leave 4 empty seats (6ft) between households
 - O Chairs on the sides of the room are set in household groupings that are 6 feet apart

• The Prayground is back

A well-spaced Prayground will be available and sanitized between services

Other points

- Pre-registration is no longer required
- o Café entrance and main entrance doors will be open
- Hymnals are available for use at the first service

Safety

Keeping everyone safe and healthy continues to be a primary focus as we follow CDC and Health Department guidelines.

- We will continue sanitizing chairs and other surfaces after services
- Café will remain closed
- Staff and Church leadership will continue to monitor conditions and adjust guidelines accordingly
